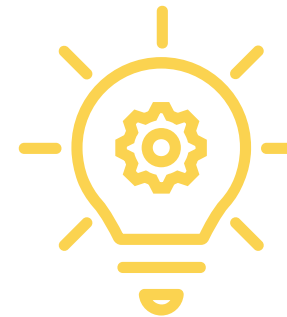

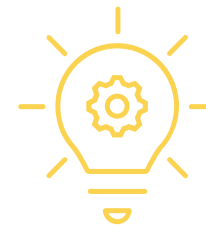
IT investment planning – A refresher

Information Technology Investment Management (ITIM)

- Management process that provides for the identification, selection, control and evaluation of IT investments driven by business needs

This is not new, and was codified in 2007

- Minimize risk
- Maximize return on investments
- Support agency decisions to maintain, migrate, improve, retire or obtain investments in support of their business needs



IT investment planning – A refresher

State government spending has risen

- In FY2007, the COV budget was **\$35.1 billion**
- In FY2023, the COV budget was **\$81.1 billion**

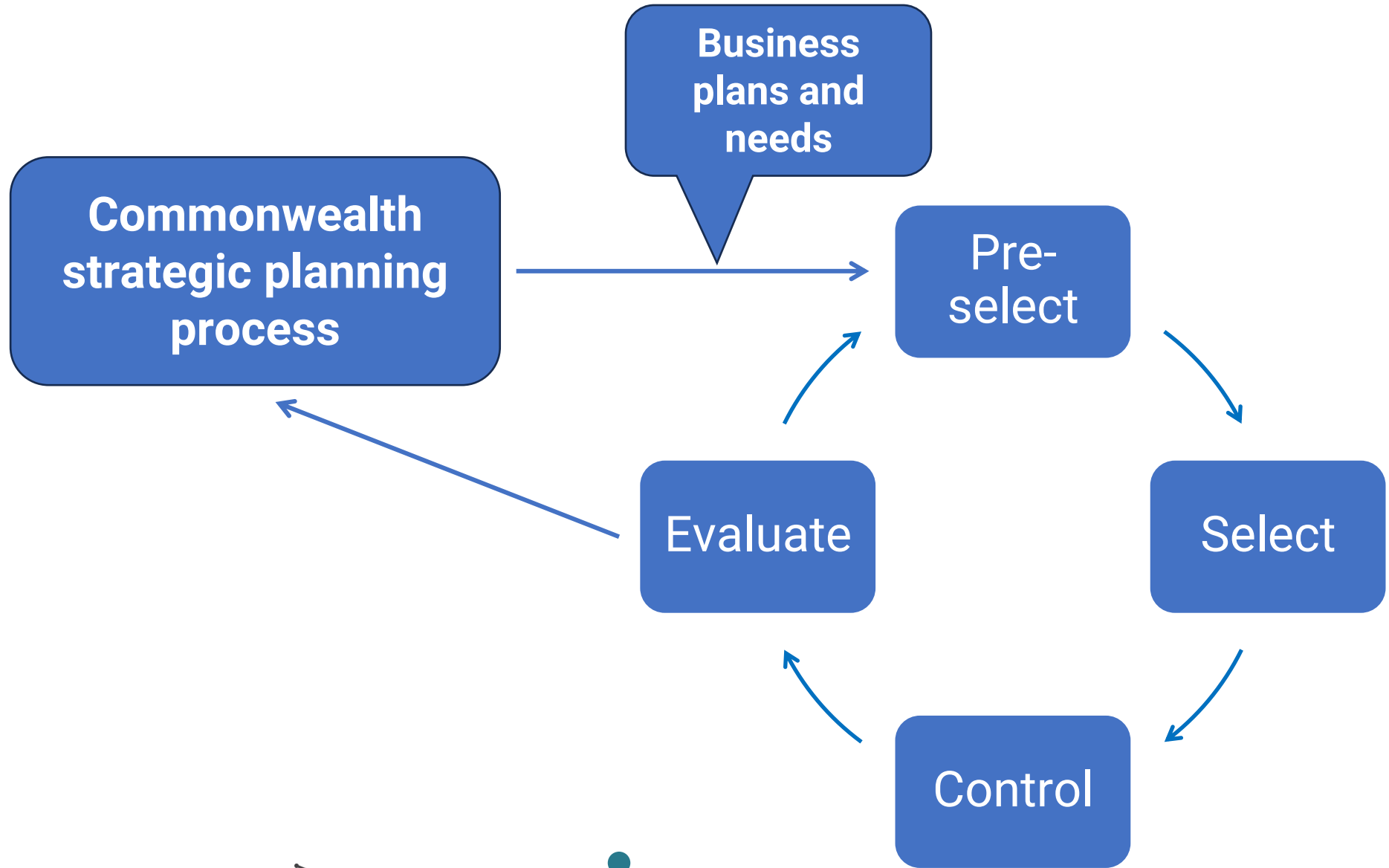


IT plays a bigger part than ever

- Technology used to augment work, now it is work and where work takes place
- Technology is not getting cheaper
- Agency budgets are not increasing to meet all needs
- More is expected from technology than ever before



ITIM is a continuous cycle



IT investment planning – A refresher

Interest in ITIM is increasing

- Successive administrations are paying more attention to this work
- The Commonwealth must demonstrate diligence in spending public money, and the IT spend is increasing



ITIM is ongoing

- What we do is not changing
- How we do it is evolving



ITIM is intrinsically linked to the Commonwealth budget cycle

ITIMD did not create the two year cycle

- Virginia operates under a two-year (biennial) budget cycle
- Governor prepares the proposed budget bill for introduction by the General Assembly
- Bill is initially adopted in even-numbered years and amended in odd-numbered years

Where the money goes, the ITSP process follows

- Biennial ITSP process aligns with the Commonwealth budget cycle
- Helps your agency demonstrate planning and forecasting
- Helps your agency be best placed to bid for the necessary funds to support business
- ITSP is essential during the whole two-year cycle, including amendment year budgets

IT investment planning – New information for agencies

Prescriptive ITSP was introduced in 2023

- ITIMD provided agencies with a new prescriptive contribution to help them develop their ITSP

Recommendations were included


- This is a new but essential element in strategic planning
- Ensuring stability and security across the Commonwealth has shared responsibilities
- Risk is a growing topic across all of IT
- Giving more useful and current data to agencies to drive improved decision-making

ITSP transformation – Prescriptive ITSP

The value

- Provides agency current state input into agency IT strategic plan
- Assists agencies in prioritizing IT investments
- Provides data from multiple sources in one location
- Supports technology modernization and funding needs

We surveyed 20% of agencies

- 
- Liked the convenience of information in one place

ITSP transformation – Prescriptive ITSP

Identified format issues

- Very manual process
- Slow, resulting in outdated information
- Only produced once every two years

Changes underway

- Transitioning from PDF document to online dashboards
- Moving from static information to dynamic (continuous updates)
- Moving from formal distribution to immediate access (24/7) (No intermediary)
